

Cash For The Community (CFTC) 2008 – Terms and conditions:

- Clubs and societies with a formal constitution, or affiliated to a regional or national association or federation, or a registered charity. Groups must be run on a voluntary basis and be based within the Advertiser news area, including Windsor and Twyford. The editor's decision will be final in determining eligibility. - Groups must register to participate in the CFTC scheme prior to its launch.
- All final entries must be made on an official entry form - to be supplied to participating groups – and accompanied by the number of tokens stated on the entry form.
- Entries must be received at the Advertiser's office at 48 Bell Street, Maidenhead, Berkshire, SL6 1HX, by 5pm on Monday, December 8, 2008.
- Only official tokens printed in the Advertiser will be accepted. No photocopies please.
- The £5,000 top prize will be allocated to the participating group which collects the highest number of tokens. In the event of two or more groups collecting the same number of tokens, the money will be divided equally between them.
- The remaining £15,000 prize money will be divided equally among the remaining participating groups which collect a minimum of 200 tokens.
- The money can be used for anything that will benefit your group and the community it serves, such as new equipment, sports kit, computers, funding for a trip or speaker, or put towards a bigger long-term project.
- Proof of postage of tokens is not proof of receipt.
- The editor's decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into.
- The winning group will be expected to take part in promotional photography and publicity.
